

# 2020 Spring Social Competition

## MONDAY nights at Willoughby Leisure Centre (A1 and B2)

- **Entries OPEN:** Tuesday, August 18<sup>th</sup> 10am
- **Entries CLOSE:** Thursday, August 27<sup>th</sup> 10am
- **Competition DATES:** Monday September 7th – November 30th (12 weeks)

- Please take the time to read the [latest list of Covid-19 case locations from NSW Health](#) and do not attend any SNV event if you have visited these locations in the previous 14 days.

Advise SNV as soon as possible if you become unwell with flu like symptoms or have a positive Covid-19 test within 14 days of attending any SNV event

## COVID-19 Safety

### IN THE VENUE

- Comply with the requirement to use **hand sanitiser (supplied) before the session, during time outs, drink breaks or change of ends and after the game/session**
- **No spectators** allowed for now
- Some venues have **no water fountains** in use so please bring 1 or 2 FULL and LABELLED drink bottles
- **Sign in on arrival & ensure names on score sheets are 100% accurate and legible**
- **Remain 1.5m from others wherever possible**, including placing your belongings 1.5m apart, bench players sit 1.5m apart, duty scorers sit 1.5m apart etc
- **Limit use of communal facilities as much as possible**, there will be toilets but no change rooms available
- Follow the advice to “**arrive, train/play, go home**” and avoid lingering or mingling with others
- **Refrain from team huddles, high fives, handshakes, kissing, hugging and any other physical contact**
- **Do not share personal equipment** such as whistles, tape, scissors, towels, shirts, food or drink. No food or drink apart from water allowed in the venue.
- In line with NSW Health, we recommend the wearing of a mask whilst doing duty
- **Do not use spit or sweat to wipe anything, including shoes**
- **Sneeze or cough in to your elbow, avoid touching your face**
- **Warm up and match balls should be cleaned with wipes before and after the warm up/game (wipes supplied)**
- **Referee stand & scoring equipment should be wiped down between games**
- **Pens will be supplied as usual and should be wiped between games, however you are encouraged to bring your own**

### BEFORE PLAYING

- **Do not attend if you are unwell**
- Do not attend if you have been in contact with a confirmed case of Covid-19 in the past 14 days or if you have been advised to self-isolate by NSW Health
- Do not attend if you have returned from another country or been on a cruise ship in the past 14 days
- Agree to a temperature check on entry if requested by the venue or SNV (not anticipated at this time)
- Comply with all current government & venue regulations regarding public health orders and advice

**Please read the *CONDITIONS OF ENTRY* carefully before completing the *ONLINE* entry form. SNV reserves the right to refuse any entry form that is incomplete or incorrect.**

Demand for placement in our competitions is often very high and unfortunately we cannot always accommodate all team entries. Priority is given to teams who have submitted their form and paid the competition fees.

**CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- 1. REGISTRATION** All players must have appropriate membership with Volleyball NSW before playing or undertaking duty
- 2. MEMBERSHIP** All players must be members of Sydney North Volleyball before they enter the court or undertake duty.
- 3. VENUES**
  - Monday Nights
    - North Ryde RSL Youth Club, cnr Pittwater & Magdala Rds, North Ryde.
    - Willoughby Leisure Centre, Small St, Willoughby
  - Wednesday Nights
    - Thornleigh Indoor Sports Stadium, 1A Dartford Road, Thornleigh
  - Sunday Nights – Women’s Comp
    - Ryde Aquatic Centre
- 4. FORMAT**

All round games start at the advertised time with a 10 minute warm up period plus a minimum of a 50 minute game. Latest finish is 11pm.

Thornleigh	- first game 7:30 pm
North Ryde	- first game 7:30pm
Willoughby	- first game 7:30pm
Women	- first game 7pm

Each competition will be of round robin format plus finals where possible.
- 5. GRADES**

All teams may nominate for only one grade on the entry form. The SNV Board reserves the right to alter a team’s nominated grade if necessary to achieve a balance of teams in each grade and maintain an appropriate standard within the grades. This will be done by assessing a team’s player profile and previous competition results. Final placement will be at the discretion of the Competitions Director.

The grades are as follows:

A1	Willoughby	Advanced
A2 & B1	North Ryde	Advanced & Very Experienced
B2	Willoughby	Intermediate
B	TISS	Intermediate
W	RALC	Women (Intermediate)

- 6. LATE ENTRY FEE** The discounted entry fee will not apply to entries received after the closing date. You may consult the Administrator for an extension of time.
- 7. TEAM ENTRIES** Entries for this competition are open for a minimum of 1 week prior to the closing date and may be lodged at any time from the opening date. Entries remain open until the closing date or the competition is full beforehand. Priority is given to entries lodged with competition fees paid in full.
- 8. COMPETITION FEES** The competition fee covers all costs directly associated with the competition including court hire, equipment, venue managers, referees, prizes and administration. The competition fee is payable in advance with priority being given to entry forms which are lodged with competition fee paid in full.
- 9. UNIFORMS** All players must wear their team's full uniform by the third round of competition. Uniforms consist of matching shirts in both colours and design with permanent numbers in contrasting colour front (at least 2cm thick and 10cm in size) and back (at least 2cm thick and 20cm in size) and shorts/pants of the same colour. Correct shoes must be worn at all times. No bare feet players allowed. Non-marking sole sport shoes must be worn at all SNV venues.
- 10. DUTY** Each team is requested to have two badged referees. If, at the time of entry, a team does not have two badged referees it will be necessary for two team members to attend a NSWVRA Referee Course as soon as possible. Duty teams consist of 5 people being 2 referees, scorer and 2 lines people, unless advised otherwise.
- 11. EQUIPMENT** All playing teams must supply their own warm up volleyballs. Match balls are provided by the Association and are NOT to be used for warm up. All duty teams are requested to provide their own two whistles. The Association provides scoresheets, rotation slips, scoreboard, pens, linesperson flags etc.
